

Cooper Landing School Discipline Plan

The five core values of our discipline plan include:

- We are Safe
- We are Respectful
- We are Responsible
- We are Kind
- And we set good examples

These five examples help lead our school discipline into a learning environment that is safe for all students and staff.

Student behavior is modified when necessary following these general steps:

- Students are given a verbal warning when they have not followed the core values.
- One verbal warning (as age appropriate determined by staff) for an offense may be accompanied by a phone call home to the parents, conversation with parents at the end of day, and may also result in the loss of the student's free time. Loss of free time is at the discretion of staff.
- The second verbal warning for the same offense, can result in a phone call home and/or sending home for the day.
- Subsequent warnings about the same offense may lead to suspensions.

In the case of blatant disregard of the core values, such as harm to another child or blatant disrespect of any staff member, certified staff may elect to suspend a student without prior warnings. The staff member will make an attempt to contact administration in the case of any suspension but the suspension is not reliant on prior notification if the staff member believes the safety of children, or corrosion of the learning culture has been jeopardized.
